- Master of Education in Curriculum and Instruction With an Emphasis in a Content Area (*36 hours*)  
(allows high school teachers to teach dual credit classes)

#### Counseling, Kinesiology, and Special Education

- Master of Education in Training and Development (*48 hours*)
- Master's Degree in Special Education with Professional Certification as Educational Diagnostician (*36 hours*)  
Diagnostician Certification only  
(for Educators already holding a Master's Degree)
